## PUBLIC SCHOOL SUPPORT PROGRAM

Ghazali Education Trust has acquired 78 Public Schools from Punjab Education Initiative Management Authority in district Bhakkar and Mianwali where GET employed qualified teachers and introduced modern school management systems in these public schools, renovated school buildings and provision of missing facilities like rooms, washrooms, furniture and drinking water, free books and uniforms.

After acquiring these schools GET increased enrollment in these schools up to 8 times in comparison with previous enrollment and currently 10,926 students are studying. Introduced and implemented digital monitoring mechanism which helped us in Scoring highest pass percentage (90%) in QAT conducted by PEF compared to all other partner organization.

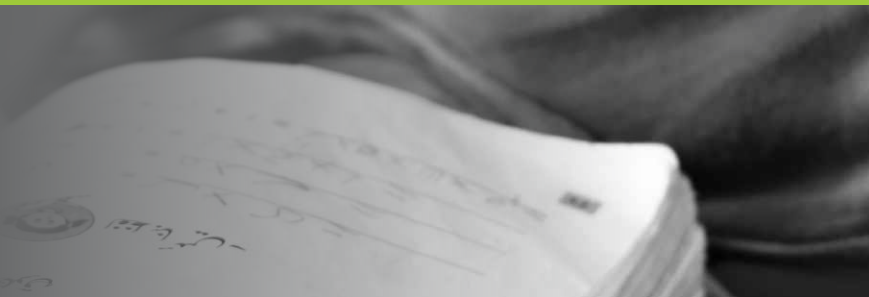

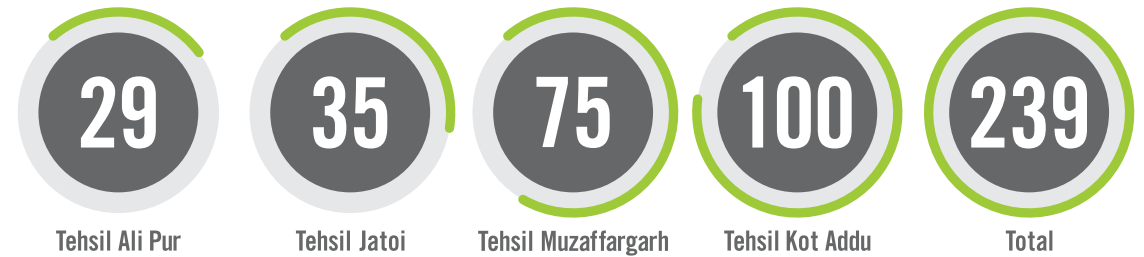
# OUT OF SCHOOL CHILDREN ENROLMENT PROGRAM



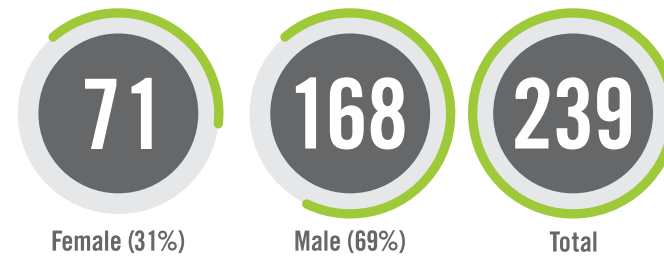
Recent reports suggested that out of the 51.53 million children between the age of 5 and 16, as many as 22.84 million (44 %) are out of school. Pakistan is facing with the highly serious challenge of millions of out-of-school children. Poverty and parents lack of interest to enroll their children in schools are the main factors that are leading children to the workplace instead of schools. GET in collaboration with Punjab Education Foundation and Department for International Development (DFID) has initiated the project to alleviate the pitiful condition of education in district Muzaffargarh having the lowest literacy rate. GET has established 239 schools in which around 23 thousand (23,744) students are fulfilling their quest of knowledge. More than 990 teachers and one field office at Muzaffargarh operating with 20 field officers' team, we have achieved 93% result in quality assurance test (QAT) conducted by the PEF.



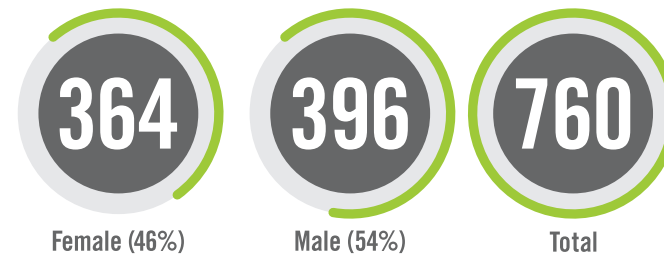

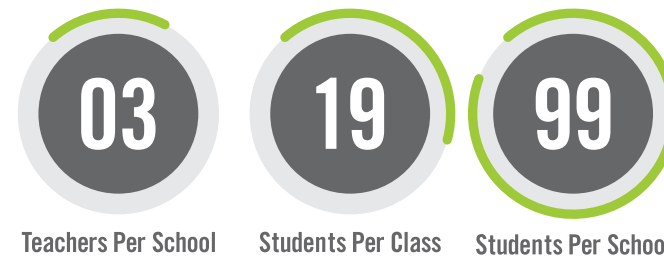

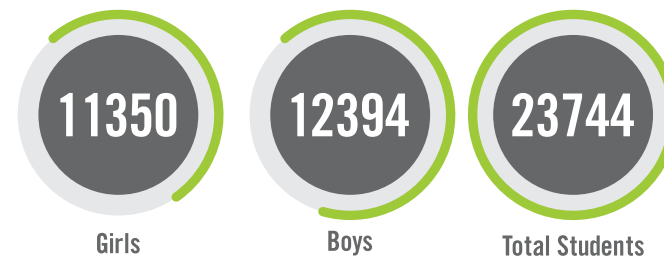

# NEW SCHOOL PROGRAM

Pakistan Rural Education Program (PREP) is working in rural settings for marginalized communities. PREP has established 669 schools in constituencies of villages where no educational facilities were available. Mostly these schools are in rental buildings, students are provided with books, stationary, uniform and fee waiver facilities. PREP operates with the cooperation of local communities and influential people for providing the educational opportunities.

# ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

GET students performed exceptionally in Punjab Examination Commission and Quality Assurance Test (QAT) conducted by PEF. 763 students of GET appeared in the board examination 2018 of 10th grade. Result was amazing at 96.5%. 1694 students appeared in the 8th grade examination with 92% success rate. In the same year, 3990 students appeared in the examination of 5th grade where success rate was 93.6%.

# LITERATE BALUCHISTAN PROGRAM

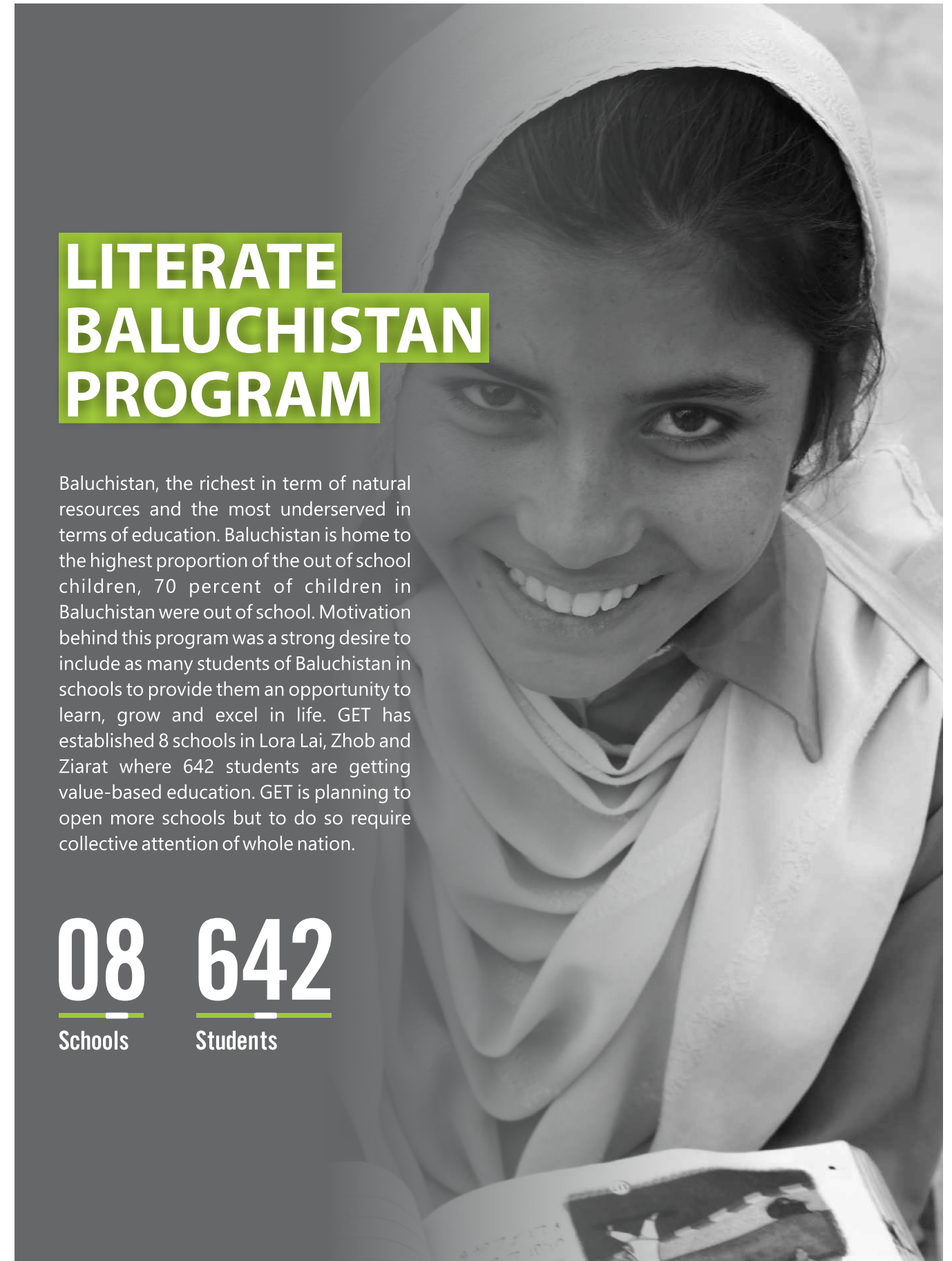
Baluchistan, the richest in term of natural resources and the most underserved in terms of education. Baluchistan is home to the highest proportion of the out of school children, 70 percent of children in Baluchistan were out of school. Motivation behind this program was a strong desire to include as many students of Baluchistan in schools to provide them an opportunity to learn, grow and excel in life. GET has established 8 schools in Lora Lai, Zhob and Ziarat where 642 students are getting value-based education. GET is planning to open more schools but to do so require collective attention of whole nation.

For the provision of quality education in rural areas of Pakistan, Land Acquisition and Construction Department has a major role in Ghazali Education Trust. LACD is responsible for providing infra-structural support which includes land acquiring, construction, renovation and arranging suitable buildings for schools. LACD exists to provide a congenial environment for students who intend to get admission in Ghazali Schools. LACD shares the responsibility to plan, design and construct the purpose-built campuses and execute the system for additional restructuring. LACD also keeps the records of all building assets of GET to ensure the transparency at all levels. In 2018, LACD has initiated 14 projects out of which 9 have been completed and 5 are at the verge of completion

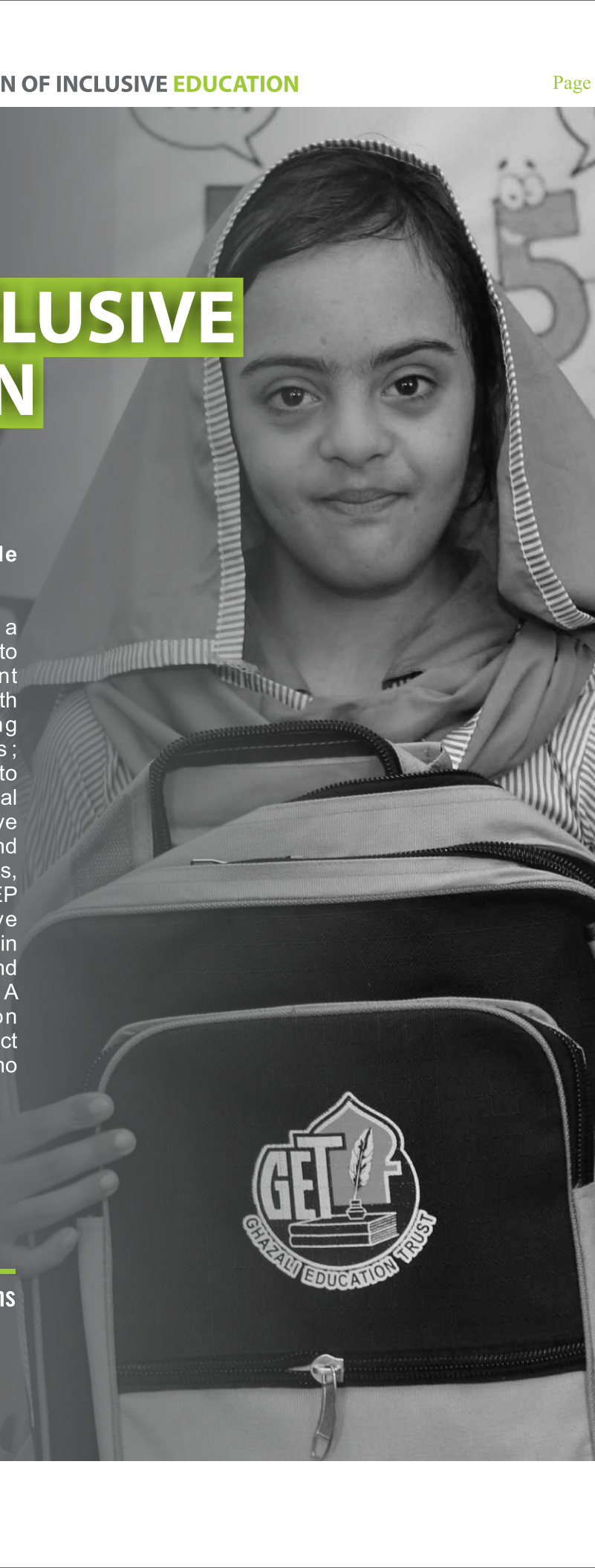
## RURAL INCLUSIVE EDUCATION PROGRAM

### Making Possibilities to include Children with Special Needs

Our whole program is based on a thought to bring a special child back to normal life. Each special student studying in our inclusive schools with resource rooms facility is being evaluated on regular basis; subsequently, we have managed to apportion many of students to normal classes. Currently, our 27 inclusive schools are providing education and training to hundreds of special students, yet there is a dire need to do more. RIEP has also initiated Rural Inclusive Vocational Training Program (RIVTP) in which computer training courses and tailoring units have been launched. A Community Based Rehabilitation Program has launched as pilot project for students with severe disabilities who cannot manage to come in schools.

# ORPHAN & NEEDY SUPPORT PROGRAM

In Pakistan millions of children are orphan or needy and majority of them are unable to get basic necessities of life. Those who cannot afford their rations cannot even think about getting education. GET initiated a separate education support program specially for these children with the name of Orphan/Needy Support Program (ONSP) to sponsor the educational expenditures of deserving students, those children who do not have parents or their parents cannot afford their education. So far 47000 orphan and needy students have been benefited from GET's exclusively designed education program for the orphan and the needy ones in more than 38 districts of Pakistan. These beneficiary students are provided with complete educational packages including shoes, bags, uniforms and support materials. Moreover, Ghazali has also offered Higher Education Scholarship Programme to bright students. However, we have yet to manage hundreds of students due to lack of resources.
