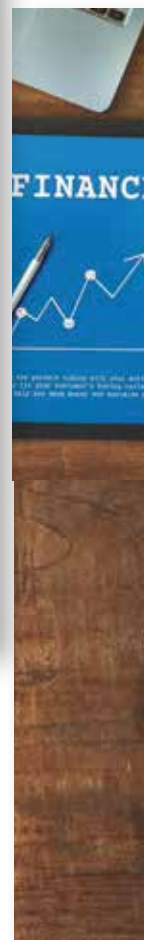

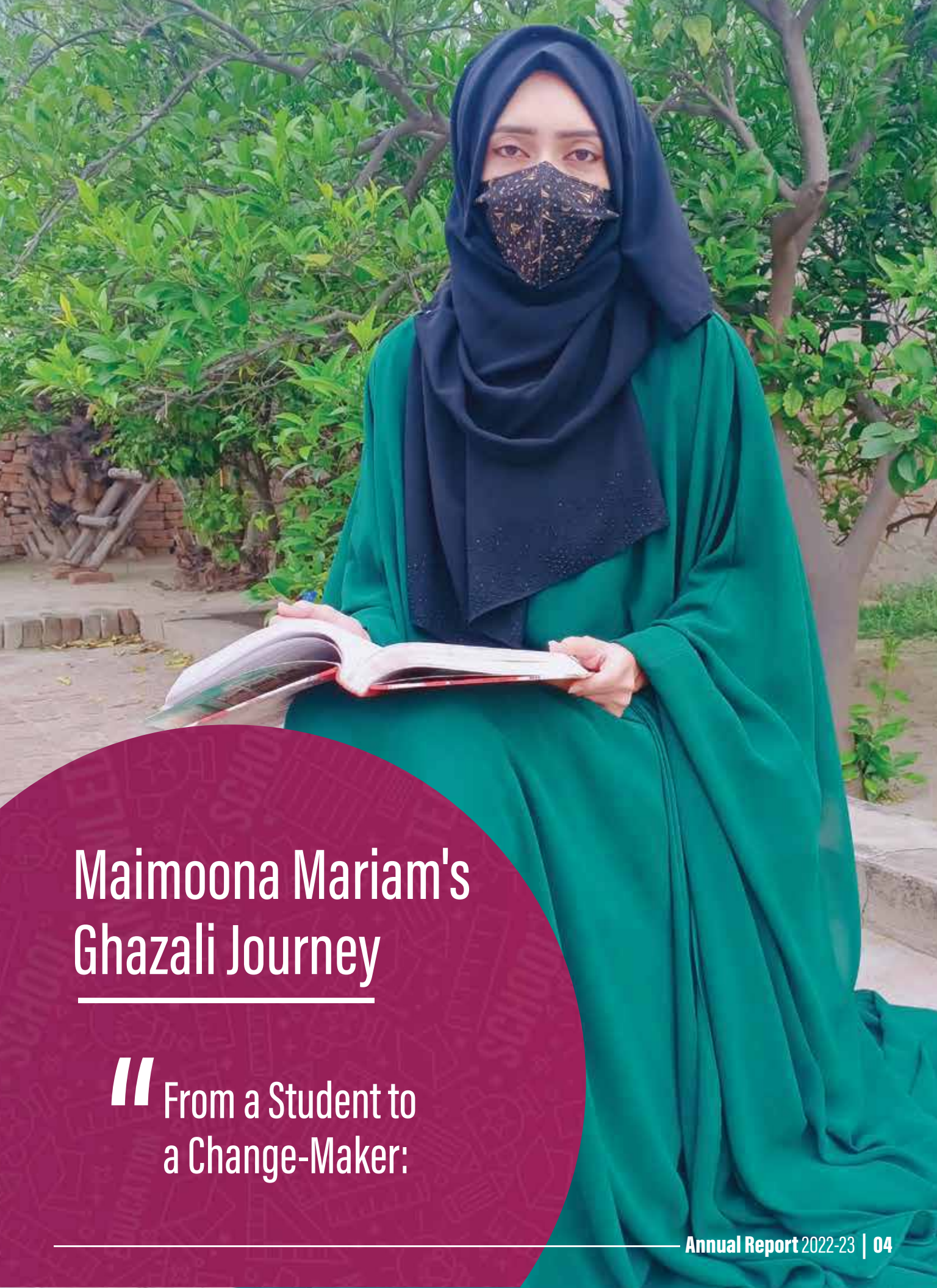

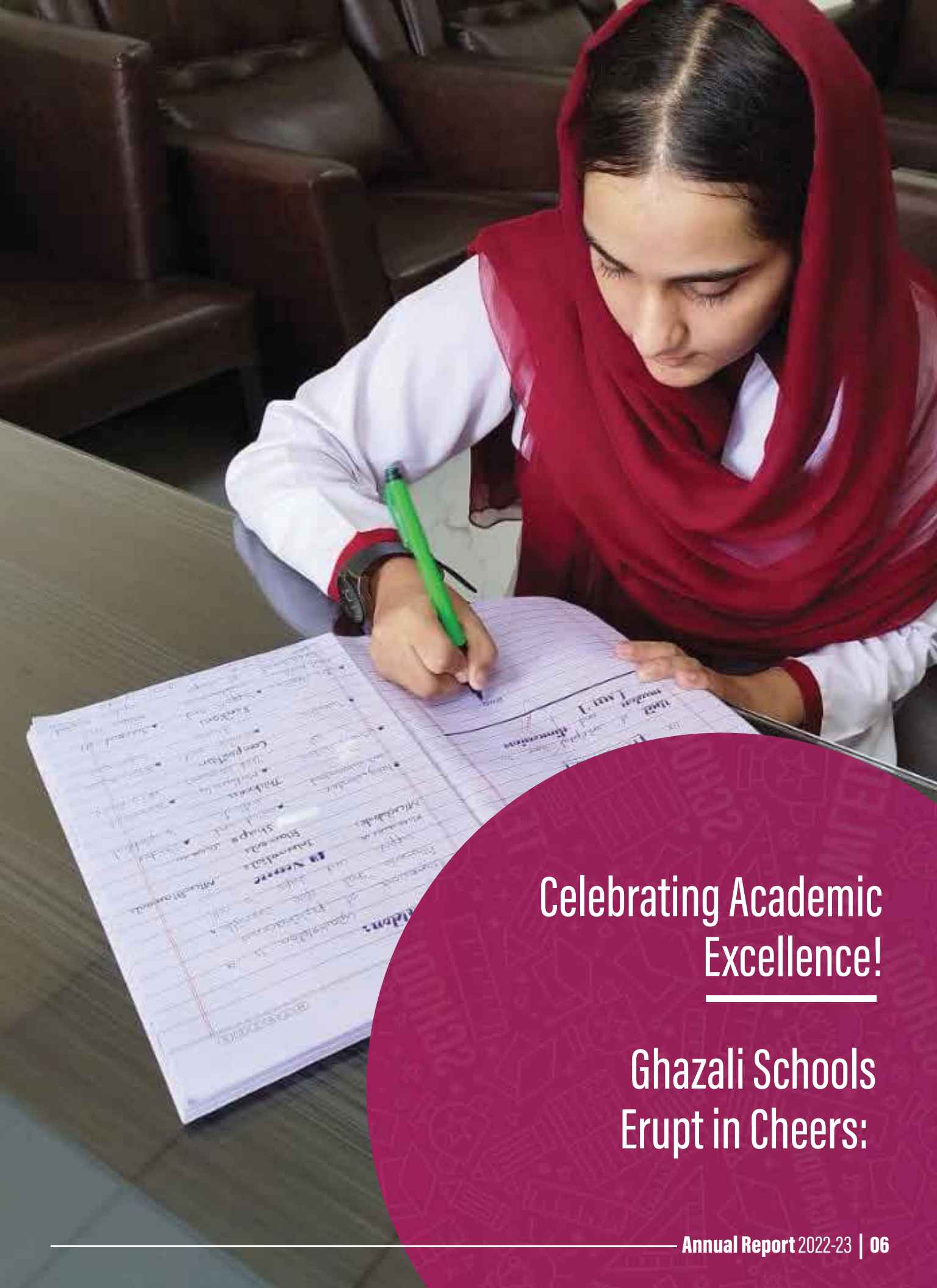
"It was always my dream to return to the place that had nurtured my love for learning," Maimoona explains, her voice filled with passion.

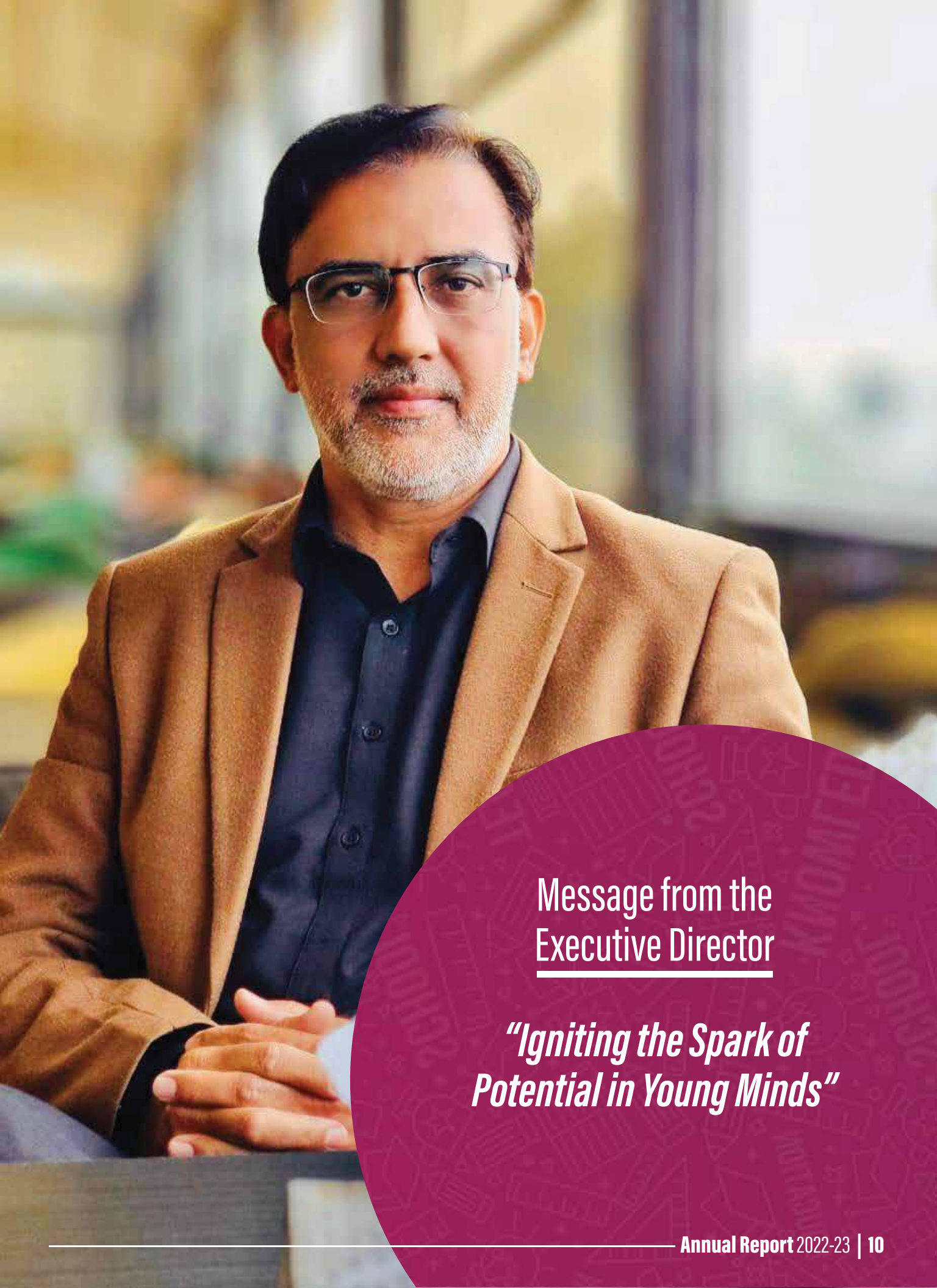

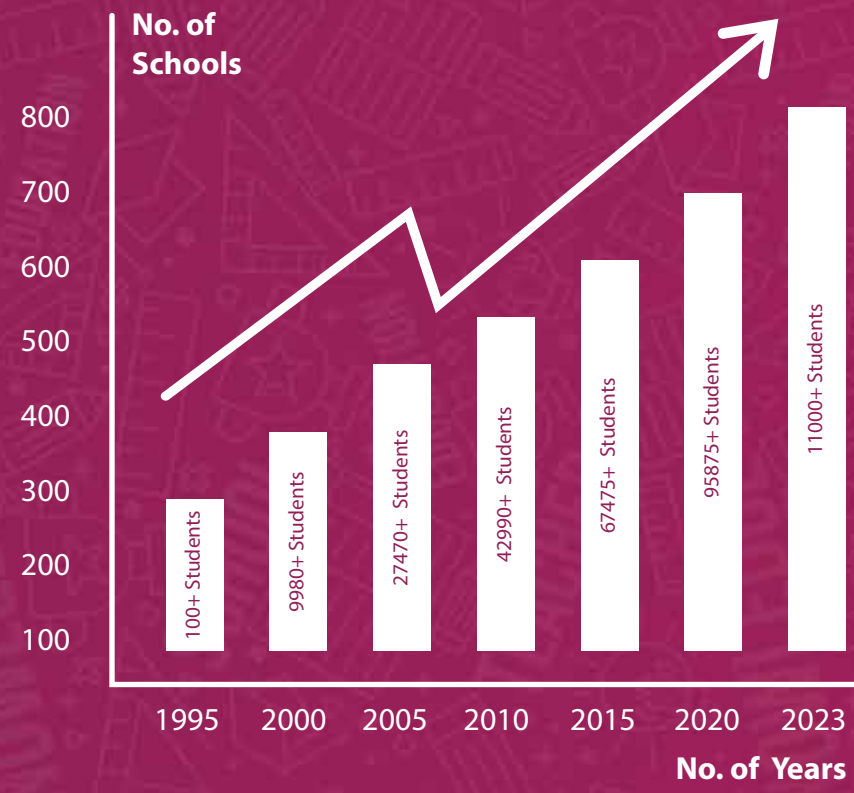
# About GET

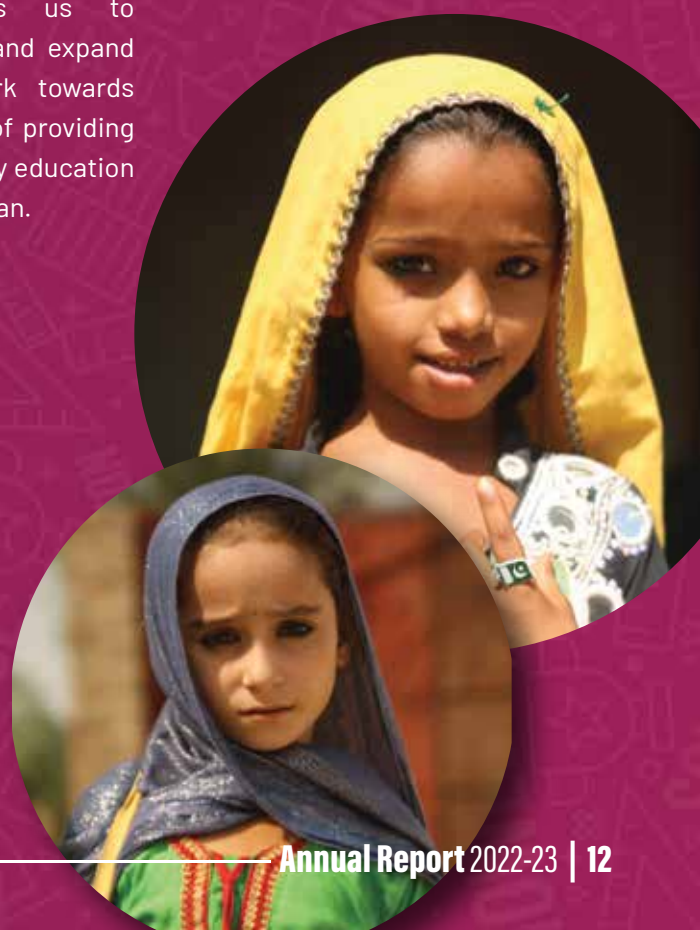

## From Despair to Dreams: A Legacy of Educational Equity:

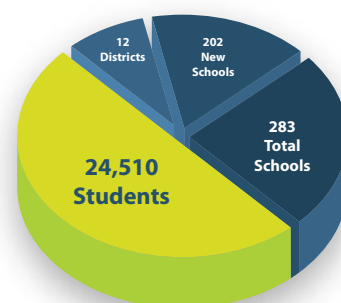

**In the academic year 2022-2023 alone, an impressive 200 new schools were successfully incorporated into the program, serving an additional 24,510 students.**

### Tent Schools: Providing Shelter for Learning Amidst Displacement:

In the disruptive migration of 2008/09 in North-West Pakistan, families found themselves displaced, with children's futures was in danger. Among this uncertainty, GET's "Tent Schools" emerged as shelters of hope. Separate spaces for girls and boys sprang up in camps like

Sheikh Yaseen and Parhooti, resonating with the vibrant hum of learning. Hundreds of children originate support in morning and evening programs, reclaiming their academic footing while holding onto hope and confidence. GET became more than an educator; it became a beacon of stability and resilience.



## Earthquake Echoes: Rebuilding Lives, One Brick at a Time

October 8, 2005, marked a day of devastation when an earthquake shattered lives. Amidst the rubble, GET, alongside the Foundation of the Faithful (FOF), rose to the challenge. Recognizing the shattered dreams and orphaned futures, they embarked on a mission of rebuilding – not just physical structures, but lives. With generous support from FOF USA, they provided free education to countless children, offering books, bags, uniforms, and a safe haven within earthquake-ravaged schools.

GET's approach extends beyond brick-and-mortar structures. They actively engage communities, fostering a strong understanding of the transformative power of education. By mobilizing families, they plant the seeds of hope, nurturing a collective commitment to learning.

## 29 Beacons of Opportunity:

This collaborative effort has yielded remarkable results. Since its inception, the program has established 29 new schools across two districts in rural Pakistan. These schools serve as beacons of knowledge, empowering over 2,192 students to embark on their educational journeys.

Beyond classrooms, GET ensures each school provides a nurturing environment conducive to learning. This includes essential amenities like clean water, nutritious meals, and a safe space for students to thrive.

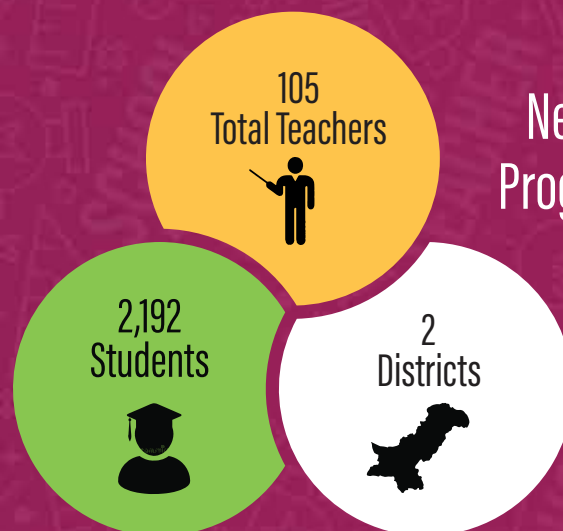
## Investing in the Future:

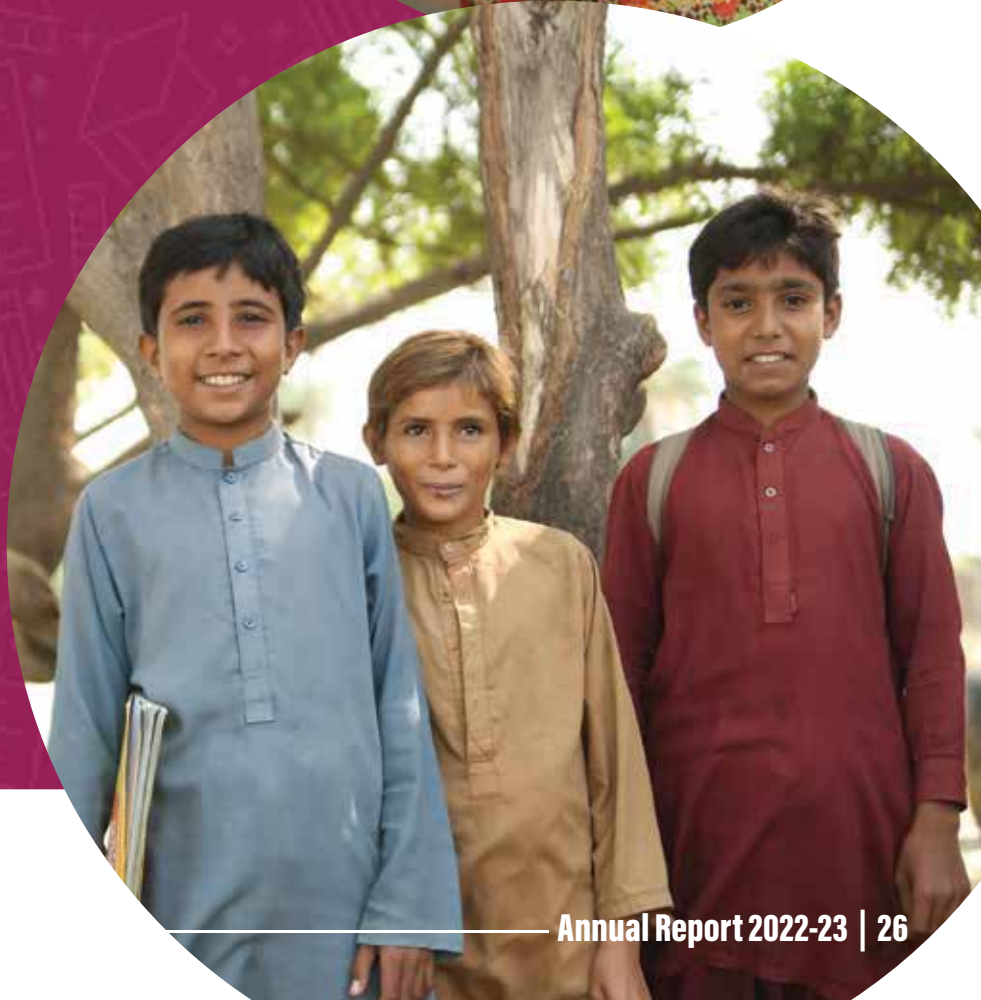
# Literate Balochistan Program

## // Whisper of Hope in the Balochistan Breeze:

The story of Balochistan is not just about deserts and dry lands; it's about dreams waiting to grow and potential held back by the lack of education. In this quiet place, Ghazali Education Trust (GET) stands as a strong source of hope, driven by the goal of a

"Literate Balochistan."

In 2011, GET set out with a big dream. They saw Balochistan not just as a province, but as a shared responsibility, a place that could be transformed with education. Starting with seven schools in the remote areas of Ziarat and Lorelei, they planted the seeds of change. These seeds grew into schools where children's laughter filled the classrooms, and their minds were lit up with knowledge





## Breaking Barriers, Building Bridges:

Education knows no gender, caste, or creed. GET embraced this belief, making sure their doors are open to everyone, both boys and girls. Their awareness campaigns, led by local voices, connected with the communities, clearing up misconceptions and sparking understanding. Mothers became advocates, fathers adopted new viewpoints, and enrollment started to climb.

Today, with girls making up 46% of the students, GET schools stand as proof of this commitment. In the farthest corners of Balochistan, where hundreds of children receive quality education close to home, their eyes shining with the hope of a future where illiteracy is just a distant memory.

## Seeds of Education, Rooted in Hope:

"Literate Balochistan" goes beyond seven schools. GET, like a dedicated gardener, nurtures hope across the province. Since 2010, the Balochistan Literacy Program has expanded, opening eight new schools and welcoming another 1,150 students. From

Here, students learn not just core subjects but also their own language and cultural values,

fostering a sense of identity and belonging. These schools are more than classrooms; they are bridges, connecting communities to the mainstream through the universal language of education.

Pakistan's tapestry is rich with diverse threads, each community enriching the vibrant fabric of the nation. Yet, some threads face the harsh sunlight of inequality, particularly the Hindu community in rural South Punjab and Sindh. Access to education, a fundamental right, becomes obscured by a lack of resources and cultural hurdles.

But amidst this challenge, Ghazali Education Trust (GET) emerges as a beacon of hope, its mission etched in the very name – Education for All. Recognizing the dire need for educational opportunities for minority students, GET embarked on a mission to empower the Hindu community through knowledge.

# Shining a Light Across Sindh: GET's Education Journey Spreads Knowledge Far and Wide

Ghazali Education Trust (GET) is on a mission – to illuminate every corner of Pakistan with the radiant beam of education. And nowhere is this dedication more evident than in Sindh, where the Ghazali Sindh Education Program shines brightly.

## Forging Partnerships, Building Futures:

Collaborating with Sindh Education Foundation (SEF), GET embarks on two impactful programs: Foundation Assisted Schools (FAS) and People Assisted Schools (PAS).

**In FAS, they've brought education to the doorsteps of 2,700 children in remote districts, opening 9 new schools within a year!**

Five already boast purpose-built campuses, with the remaining four on track for completion by 2023. But the journey isn't without its challenges. Finding qualified teachers in these regions posed a hurdle. GET tackled this head-on, offering competitive packages and transportation incentives to draw talented female graduates from cities. They understood the importance of female educators, not just for teaching, but for inspiring local communities to embrace girls' education.

## Overcoming Hurdles, Embracing Challenges:

Local reluctance to send girls to school demanded a different approach. GET formed Local School Committees, bringing community members on board to recognize the transformative power of education for their children. Building trust and understanding became key to unlocking doors and illuminating minds.

The quest for excellence continues. Establishing all nine FAS schools with their own campuses remains a crucial target. Introducing formative assessment and shifting from rote learning to activity-based methods are additional goals, ensuring comprehensive student growth and a vibrant learning environment.

Providing career development opportunities for teachers through subject-based and

skill-oriented workshops empowers them to keep pace with evolving pedagogies. Increasing female student attendance to 50% is another ambitious yet achievable dream, one that will shatter old norms and pave the way for a brighter future for girls.

## Foundation Assisted Schools (FAS): Expanding Reach, Inspiring Innovation:

Expanding Reach, Inspiring Innovation:

GET's journey in PSP began in July 2022. SEF entrusted them with the management of two English-medium schools in urban areas, recognizing their commitment to quality education. These schools with state-of-art buildings are operating under SEF's Public-Private Partnership model, provide free education to 600 students, enriching their lives with diverse learning experiences.

## Bridging the Gap: Identification and Support

RIEP doesn't shy away from challenges. Through collaborative efforts with the Rehabilitation Institute of Pakistan comprehensive disability surveys were conducted across all our schools in **2020, 2021, and 2022**. This proactive approach identified over **700** students with various disabilities, paving the way for targeted support.

## Empowering Through Action: Stories of Transformation

RIEP goes beyond statistics. It's about witnessing the magic of potential unfold.

**Take Khubaib Ahmed, an autistic , who blossomed after receiving specialized training and is now actively engaged in class.**

Another heartwarming story comes from our Addapul 93 school, where a child successfully transitioned to mainstream classes with dedicated support. These are just a few testaments to the transformative power of RIEP's approach.

## Investing in the Future: Building Capacity

We understand that qualified and passionate educators are the backbone of inclusive education. RIEP actively invests in teachers by organizing comprehensive training sessions.

**Over 40 teachers from 11 districts across Punjab and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa recently participated in a three-day training program at the Ghazali Head Office in Lahore.**

These sessions not only equipped them with valuable skills but also fostered a sense of community among educators.

## Beyond Classrooms: Holistic Development

To create a truly inclusive environment, we've established

**28 well-equipped resource centers within our schools.**

These centers provide a treasure trove of specialized learning materials, empowering students with the tools they need to thrive.

## A Day to Remember: Celebrating Achievements

At GET, we believe that celebrating even small victories is important. This year, we organized a special recreational tour for our special children from different districts.

**The joy on their faces as they participated in games, activities, and swings at Kalarkahar,**

Lahore was truly heartwarming. It was a day filled with laughter, camaraderie, and a sense of belonging.

## Looking Ahead: A Journey of Continuous Improvement

RIEP's commitment to inclusive education is unwavering. We recently launched a new initiative to provide hearing aids to hearing-impaired children in our schools. This empowers them to actively participate in class and unlock a world of sound and learning.

Another remarkable accomplishment is the development of a comprehensive "Teacher Guide for the Assessment & Educational Planning of Children with Special Needs". This invaluable resource empowers teachers with the knowledge and tools to create individualized learning plans for each student.

**The CBR (Community Based Rehabilitation) program is another facet of RIEP's impactful work. Currently operating in three villages of Faisalabad, it provides education to 30 students in a supportive and accessible environment. With 28 resource rooms catering to the needs of 1600+ special children in Ghazali and 650+ Special Students in RIEP and a dedicated team of 35 trained teachers,**

RIEP is making significant strides towards inclusive education. But our journey doesn't end here. We are constantly seeking new ways to improve, expand our reach, and ensure that every child, regardless of their abilities, has the opportunity to learn, grow, and thrive.





# Orphan/Needy Support Program(ONSP)



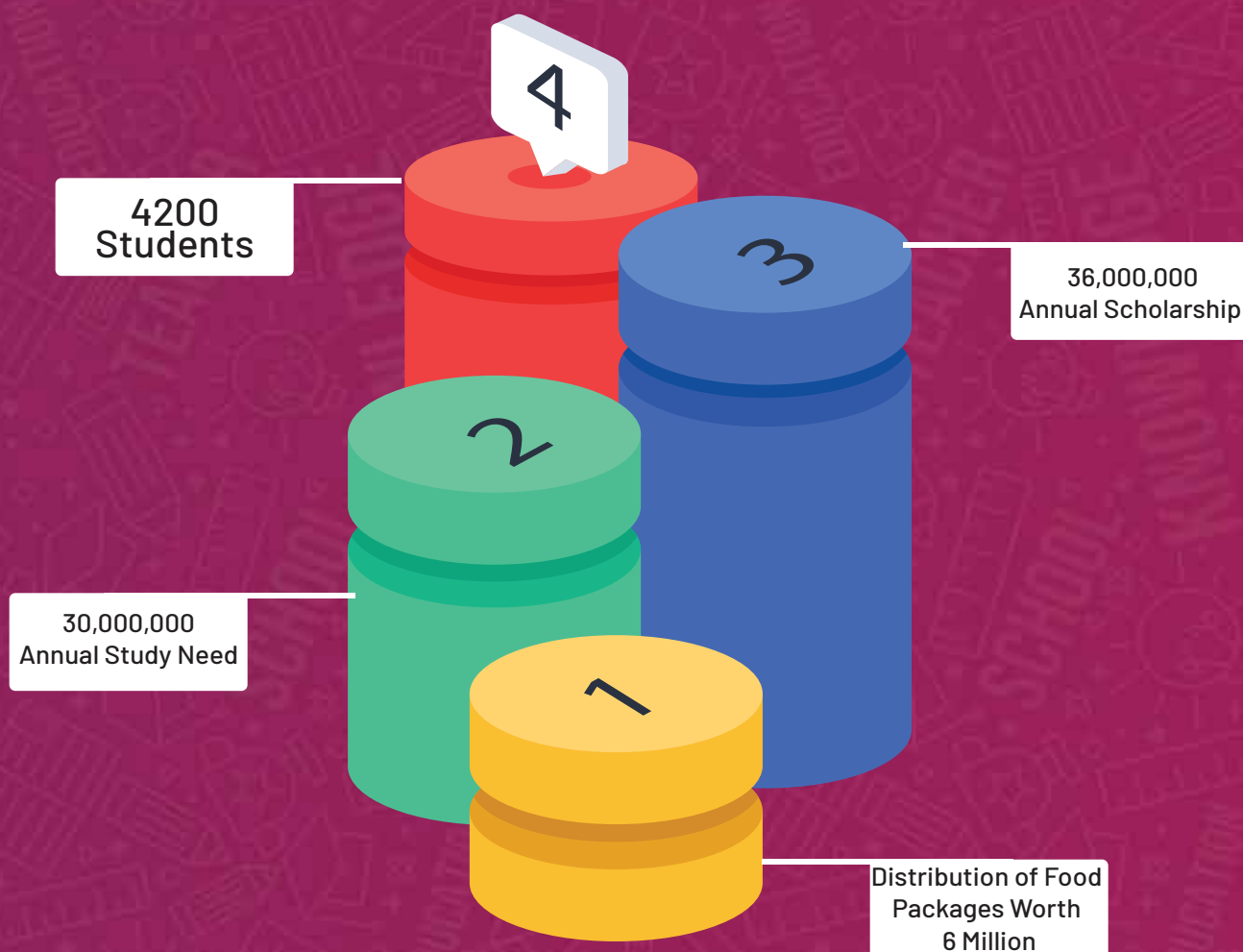




At Ghazali Education Trust (GET) we believe every child deserves a chance to shine, regardless of their background. This conviction fuels our Orphan and Needy Support Program (ONSP), a beacon of hope for 4,200 orphaned and underprivileged students across rural Pakistan.

## A Story of Hope Realized:

Imagine a young orphan, with future clouded by uncertainty. Our ONSP program intervenes, offering a ray of hope. By covering tuition fees, providing essential supplies, and addressing basic needs, we empower families to keep their children in school. This empowers these young minds to dream big and reach their full potential.



## Beyond Textbooks: A Holistic Approach:

The ONSP program goes beyond merely providing essential school supplies, like bags, uniforms, shoes, books, and stationery. We recognize that education flourishes when basic needs are met. So, we invest over PKR **37.2** Million monthly

to cover school tuition fees, alleviating a significant burden for struggling families. Additionally, we provide school supplies worth **PKR 40 Million**, ensuring each child has the tools they need to succeed.

## Empowering Families, Nurturing Dreams:

For many in our program, the challenges extend beyond education.

**40% of our beneficiaries come from families facing severe financial hardships. Here, GET steps in as a lifeline. We offer impactful initiatives like Ramadan food packages and daily lunch, easing the pressure on families and allowing them to prioritize their children's education.**

**The results are undeniable. Reduced dropout rates in rural areas showcase the impact. When families witness GET's unwavering commitment to their children's well-being, the path towards education becomes clearer.**



## Celebrating Excellence:

GET doesn't stop at fostering educational opportunities. We recognize and reward exceptional achievement.

**In 2023, we awarded higher education scholarships to the top three girls achieving A+ grades in their Matriculation exams.**

This serves as an inspiration to all our students, demonstrating that dedication and hard work pave the way for a brighter future.

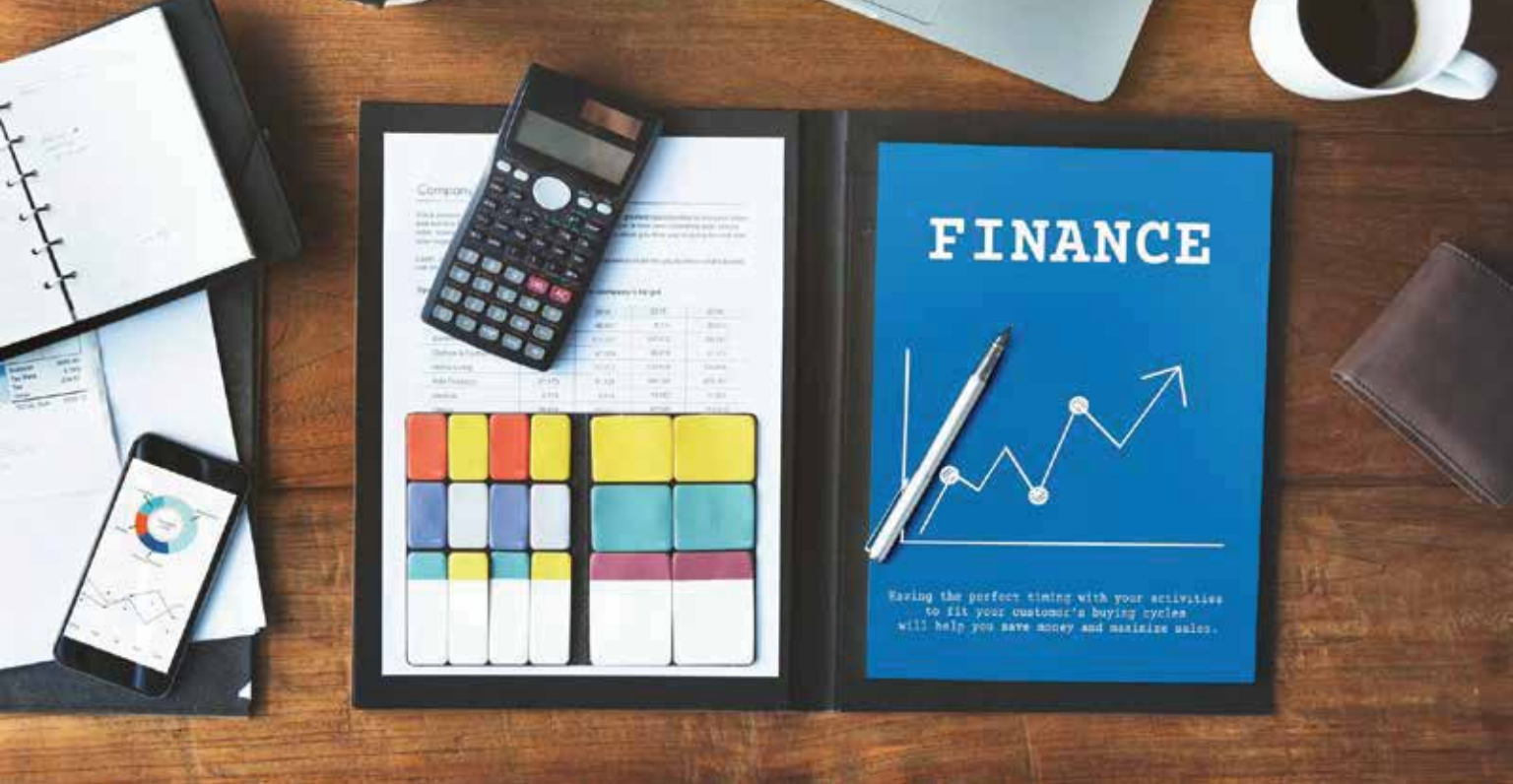


## Budget Revenue 2022
